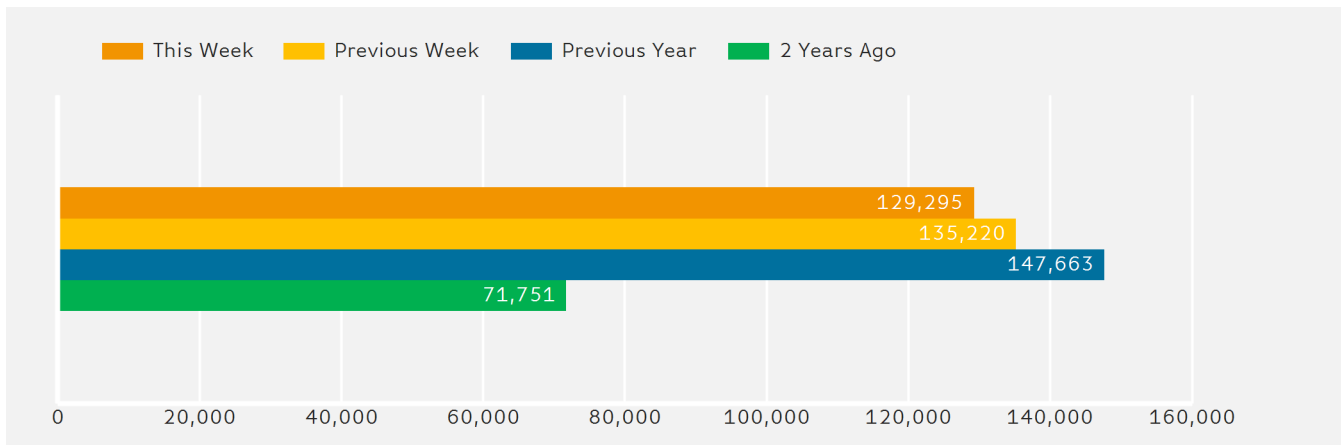

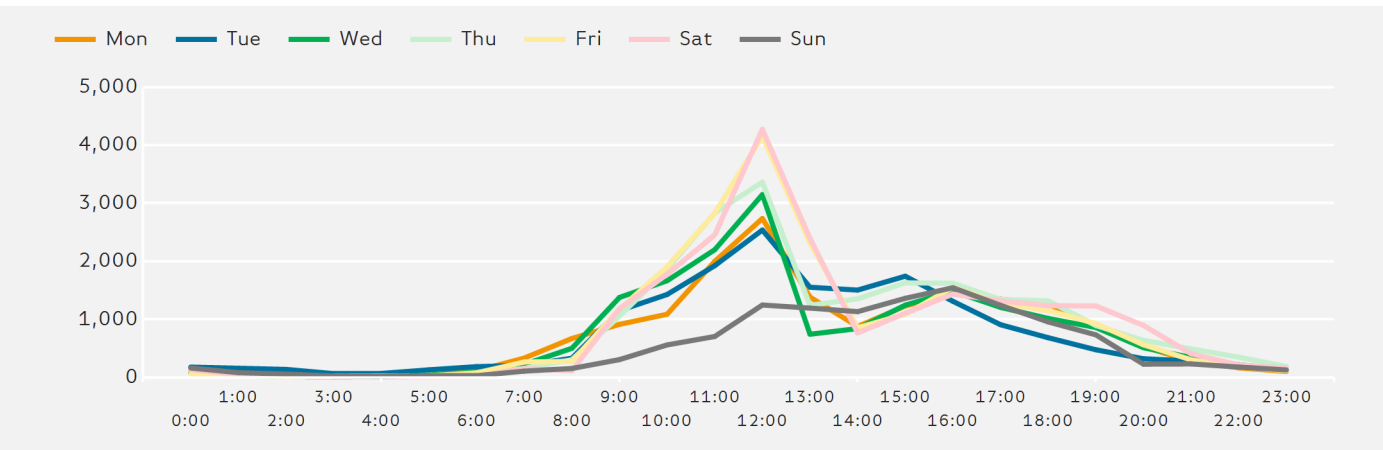
#### Headlines

#### Ped Counts Totals by Week



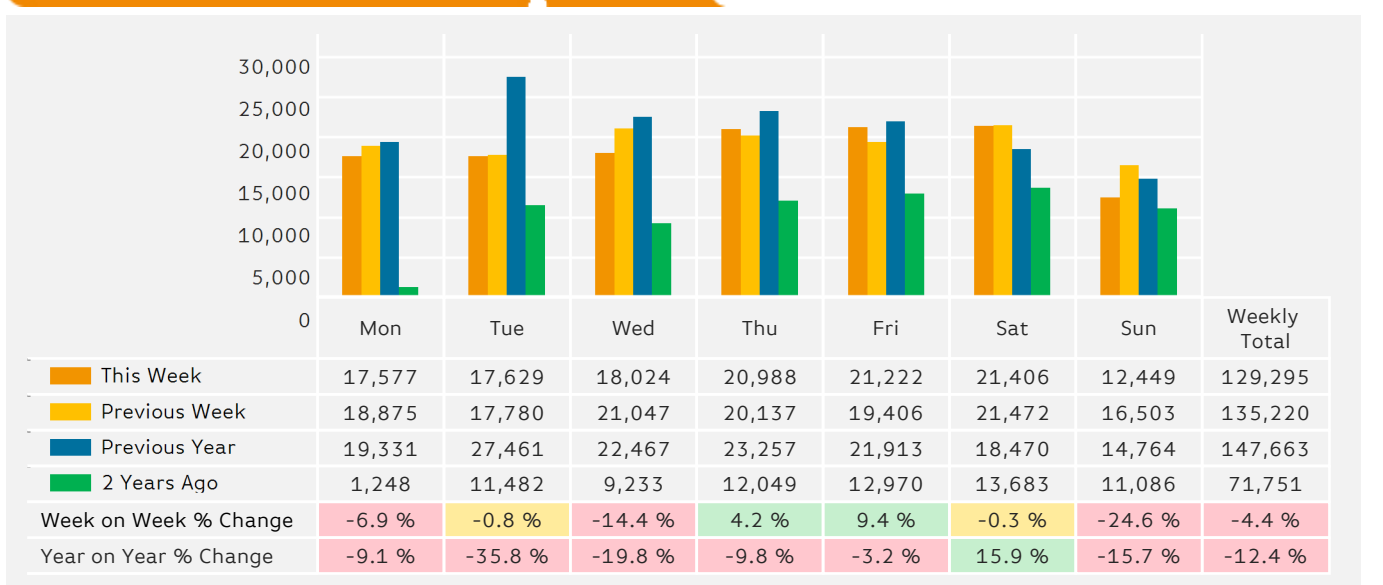
### Ped Counts by Hour

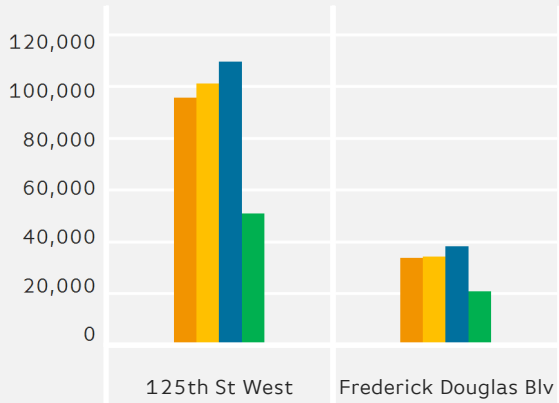

### Ped Counts by Day



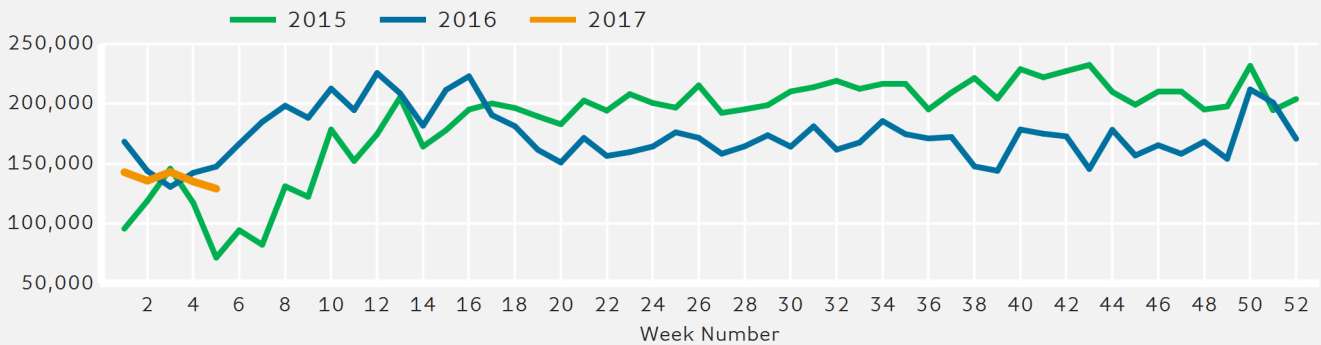
